Youth Ministry

The Youth Ministry of Perry Beeches Baptist Church provides spiritual guidance for the youth of our church by responding to their social and

spiritual needs. Meeting every second and fourth Sunday of the month, our sessions run alongside the Sunday worship service and allows the youth leave part way through the service to be involved in “youth church”, a discussion and teaching session, facilitated by our youth leaders.

We also encourage the youth to use their individual talents in serving the Lord, through a dedicated youth led service, and being involved in church activities, such as bible reading, ushering, corporate prayer and being involved in other church ministries that interest them. Bible Study is run on every fortnight on a Thursday from 6pm – 7pm, with our very own Pastor Tracy, in addition to singing practice on a Tuesday evening for those eager to develop their singing voice, with our Choir Director.

The youth also enjoy an array of events and activities throughout the year, such as Youth Retreat, Youth Social and community fundraising events.
