

Advance notice of draft resolutions.

The following is the draft wording for the resolutions to be put to a Members Meeting to be held in the spring of 2021, with a view to authorising the Church's transition to charity status: -

"It was resolved that:-

1. The members approved the incorporation of the Church as a [Charitable Incorporated Organisation \(CIO\)](#) with the constitution published on the Church website – perrybeechesbaptistchurch.co.uk
2. At the point of incorporation, the Members of the Church will automatically become the first members of the [CIO](#)
3. Following the establishment of the CIO the Members give authority to the trustees of the Church to effect the transfer of assets (other than property held on separate property trusts), liabilities and activities of the Church to the [CIO](#); and
4. Following the establishment of the [CIO](#) the members give authority to the trustees of the Church and the property holding trust corporation, to recognise the [CIO](#) as being the Church with the benefit of the property which is held on behalf of the Church i.e. the land situated at the corner of Beeches Road and Sandy Lane in Birmingham, together with the buildings and contents therein placed on the said land
